



LOCAL RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Amgen maintains an extensive clinical trial program and invests significantly in local research and development. Amgen's history of clinical trial activity in Australia dates back over 35 years and our reputation for quality and safety continues to make us one of the most trusted destinations in the world for Amgen research. In 2022, this included over 1,700 Australian patients, participating in 48 clinical trials at leading Australian hospitals.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

- Donations enabling the work of others through donations, particularly in the areas of clinical research and ongoing medical education.
- Volunteering providing paid charity leave so staff can donate person-hours to support local charities and participate in our Annual Week of Service. Each year, hundreds of hours of assistance are provided to people and organisations in need.
- Environment designing practices to measure and reduce our environmental impact, particularly regarding product packaging.
